- Create conditions that promote learning and self-esteem through appropriate consideration of the affective, cognitive, and motor dimensions of learning;
- Identify how the use of words and methods help athletes relate to their preferred learning style;
- Use well-formulated feedback, offering it at the right time and with the right frequency.
